- The 'Work for Yourself - Care and Support' training equips people with the skills to become a sole trader and offer services to NDIS Participants. NDIS Participants have a wide variety of needs from mobility, general care and domestic services, these sole trader roles are for entry level people who may or may not have a qualification.

## FAQ

- What is the NDIS?
  - The NDIS is a scheme to support Australians who have a permanent and significant disability. The scheme provides funding to NDIS Participants to receive services, enabling Participants to maintain their choice and control of the services they receive. NDIS Participant plans are tailored to an individual's needs and goals.
- What is the role of a Sole Trader in Disability Services?
  - A Sole Trader provides a variety of services to NDIS Participants.
  - Duties may include assistance with daily life and everyday needs, household cleaning, yard maintenance, support to attend appointments and shopping.
  - Duties can also include assistance with social and community participation, such as assisting a person to participate and/or contribute in the community.
